What is Arabic Data?

Is an online system to track and monitor the Formative and Summative data for the MOE subjects.

- Social Studies for Arabs.
- Social Studies for Non-Arabs.

Formative assessment Vs Summative assessment


Formative assessment

- Formative assessment is used to monitor student's learning to provide ongoing feedback that can be used by instructors or teachers to improve their teaching and by students to improve their learning.
- Formative assessment is an ongoing activity. The evaluation takes place during the learning process. Not just one time, but several times.
- With formative assessments, you try to figure out whether a student's doing well or needs help by monitoring the learning process.
- For formative assessment, the purpose is to improve students learning. In order to do this, you need to be able to give meaningful feedback.
 Check out this post about feedback.
- Formative assessment includes little content areas. For example 3 formative evaluations of 1 chapter.
- The formative assessment considers evaluation as a process. This way, the teacher can see a student grow and steer the student in an upwards direction.


Summative assessment

- Summative assessment is used to evaluate student's learning at the end of an instructional unit by comparing it against some standard or benchmark.
- The summative evaluation takes place at a completely other time. Not during the process, but after it. The evaluation takes place after a course or unit's completion.
- When you use summative assessments, you assign grades. The grades tell you whether the student achieved the learning goal or not.
- For summative assessment, the purpose is to evaluate students' achievements.
- A summative assessment includes complete chapters or content areas.
 For example, just 1 evaluation at the end of a chapter. The lesson material package is much larger now.
- With summative assessment, it's harder for you to steer the student in the right direction. The evaluation is already done. That's why summative assessments or evaluations are considered to be more of a "product".












